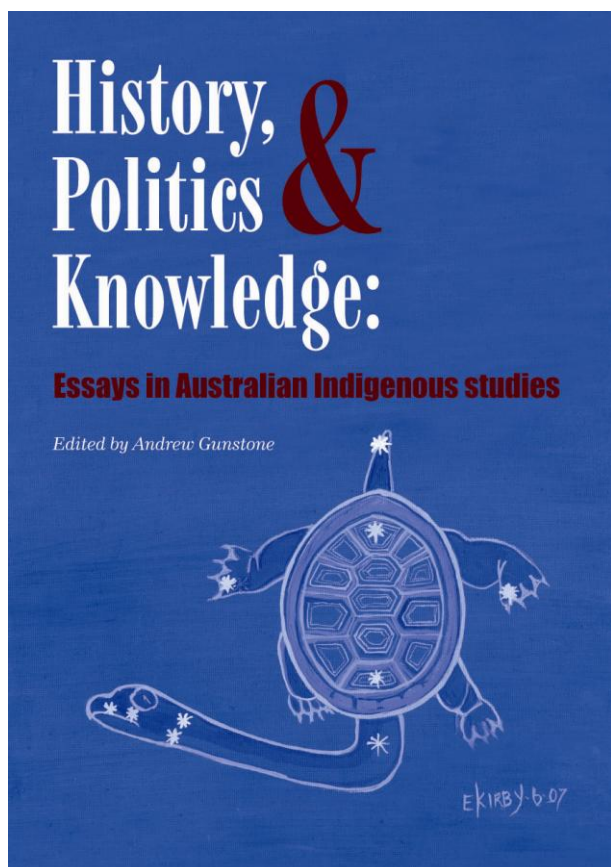


HISTORY, POLITICS & KNOWLEDGE
